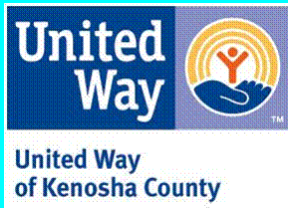




During the 2008-2009 school year, PLC will be working with 40 classes from Kenosha & Racine. The participating elementary schools in Kenosha are Armitage Academy, Bose, EBSOLA, Grant, Prairie Lane, Roosevelt and Salem. The participating Racine elementary schools are Goodland, Janes, Mitchell, Red Apple, San Juan Diego, Schulte and S.C. Johnson.

Following the last workshops in January, we will begin to schedule the booster sessions for each class. We will visit each class three times to reinforce what was taught at the workshop and to teach additional skills. Since our pilot program in May of 2006, approximately 2400 students have participated in the Peace Learning Circles program.

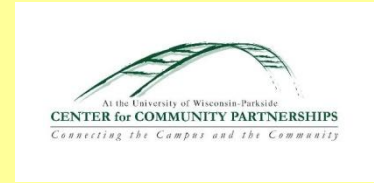
