

2009 – 2010 SATISFACTORY ACADEMIC PROGRESS APPEAL FORM

Students who are denied financial aid at UW-Parkside due to unsatisfactory academic progress (see attached policy) may appeal to have their aid reinstated. Students must have an active 2009-2010 FAFSA on file in the Financial Aid Office to be considered for the appeal process.

HOW TO APPEAL

If the Financial Aid Office has notified you of financial aid denial due to unsatisfactory academic progress per federal regulations

Return this completed form with:

- A letter explaining why you did not make satisfactory progress toward your degree

If you were under academic suspension and have been readmitted to UW-Parkside

Return this completed form with:

- A copy of the "Appeal Letter" you submitted to the Academic Actions Committee
- A "Permit to Register" form from the Academic Actions Committee

Students will be notified by letter of their appeal status. Allow at least two weeks.
